8. Guidelines :

a. Coding /Gaming

- i. Project should be according to the theme.
- ii. The participant should be able to tell the steps followed to write the code.
- iii. The game developed should have an interesting title.
- iv. The code should be perfectly running and the video of the project while you run it and get the output should also be submitted.

b. Python

- i. Avoid any plagiarism.
- ii. Negative marking for projects which are not completely theme related./ Only theme related projects will be accepted.
- iii. The proper alignment of the code will be considered while marking. There should be comments before each block of the code explaining the process.
- iv. The perfectly running code, the video of the participant running it and getting the output needs to be submitted.
- v. Extra points for the best alignment, usability, relation to the theme, smoothness of the process, errors, exceptions, explanation and uniqueness.

c. Web / App Development

General rules

- i. Brackets or any open source platform text editor software can be used.
- ii. Your site must include:
 - a) Adequate text-to-background contrast

- b) Easy-to-read font size
 - c) Easily identifiable navigation with clear and concise labels
 - d) Consistent styles and colours
 - e) Text without spelling and grammar errors
 - f) Primary navigation options must be prominent and intuitive (easy to identify).
- iii. The links must work

Technical rules

- iv. The site link should be evidenced by its appearance or by a mouse hover. Site link should open in a new window.
- v. Images that are used on your site must be saved in your images folder and linked from there. Specifically, if any image that is used on your site appears merely because you have linked to it on another site, your site will be disqualified from the competition
- vi. Your site must function and load quickly in all major browsers.(need to mention browsers and their versions).
- vii. The use of animation software is not allowed.
- viii. Individual page names must be descriptive.
- ix. Images must load correctly. Original images will be scored higher than plagiarized images.
- x. Home page must be named "index" in its url.
(Example:index.html)
- xi. CSS is preferred for layout, but not mandatory
- xii. The filenames that precede '.html' should not contain special characters, spaces, or capital letters. The filenames must be similar or identical to both the title on the page
- xiii. Bonus will be given for well indented code, proper use of HTML tags, and use of external style sheets. The external style-sheets must reside inside of your website folder.

d. Robotics :

- i. There should not be any plagiarism. It will be checked. If found, the project will be disqualified.
- ii. The project should be completely theme related
- iii. There should be a working model on Tinker cad.
- iv. The project should be perfectly working and video of the working project should also be submitted.
- v. Marking will be based on Working of projects, relation to the theme.

9. Terms and Conditions:

- A. Each team member will register with only one email ID.
- B. A team will NOT BE PERMITTED to change/replace any team member(s). A team once registered will remain unchanged till the end of competition.
- C. Failure to comply with any of the rules, terms and conditions of the competition may result in disqualification of the participating team.
- D. All participants (implicitly) consent to allow their names and photographs to be used for by Wisemindz during and after the competition.
- E. All material submitted must be the team's original work.
- F. Any kind of plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of a team.
- G. Wisemindz's decision is final and no appeals will be entertained.
- H. Only one member of the team should be designated as the team leader, who will be responsible for all communications with Wisemindz.
- I. If the team members are from the same school, they may be from different grades.
- J. Each team should have a minimum of 2 and maximum of 3 participants.

- a. The project has to be mailed from the registered mail Id on info@wisemindz.com before the deadline.
- b. The subject of the mail should be <Platform> <Name of the project>
- c. All the project related resources (images or sounds) should be sent in the same mail as an attachment.

11. Project Presentation :

The final project is to be submitted in the form of a video. The video must start with the Participant's name / School's name and Introduction of the model along with an explanation of the working of the project. The video must entirely be in English. Video exceeding the given time frame will be disqualified. **The video must not be of more than 4 mins.**

The final project will be judged on the following parameters :

- 3) Functionality
- 4) Project idea
